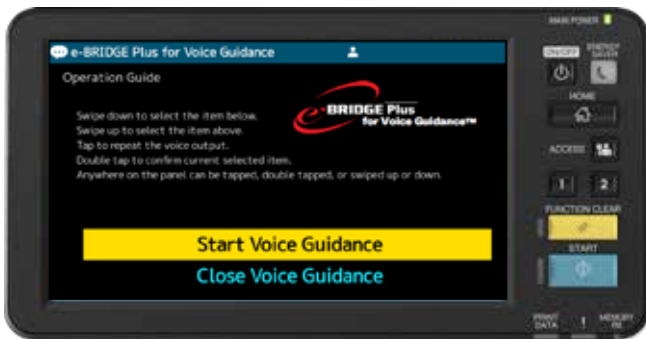
Simply scan a QR code on the device with the app when on the same network to start harnessing the power of your MFP from your mobile device.
